- ◆ The Black Caucus met today to discuss updates from Sen. O'Blenis and my meeting with UCF Police Chief Metzger. Here are some updates:
 - The department's body-worn cameras only have a buffer of 30 seconds
 - The department's diversity data does not include office staff
 - UCF PD does not use no-knock warrants when searching students' dorms
 - The department no longer has a grenade launcher, but does have "less-lethal launchers" used to fire foam bullets and tear smoke
