11. Member Discussion- Gorlin-Tarbell: Move to go informal: Approved GC

- a. Need to add point on virtual conferences and saying SG can't fund travel for the foreseeable future on FAQ sheet.
- b. Increase funding during Q3
- c. \$700,000 is set as of now for this fiscal year.
- d. Variation of virtual conference costs are a range, from free to over \$100.
- e. Budget more money for later quarters
- f. Students are taking advantage of virtual conferences more than anticipated
- g. Have 20% of budget for first quarter with rollover for future quarters.
- h. First quarter is slow for funding.
- i. \$50,000 for Q1 and \$50,000 for Q2
- j. Distance learning could be a majority of classes for the fall.
- k. Need to be more accountable for having enough money for the whole fiscal year.
- I. Good chance for rescheduled conferences to take place during Q4.
- m. \$300,000 for Quarters 3 and \$300,000 for Quarter 4.
- n. Make Q2 higher than \$50,000. Make it \$75,000 or \$100,000.
