  - a. Resolution 52-07 (Resolution Updating the Duties and Responsibilities of the GAP Committee) (Chair Galloway)
    - i. We are trying to make it consecutive with the other committees because the other committees have the ability to amend, debate and pass and statutorily we don't have that power, so we are trying to add that.
    - ii. Senator Oquendo-Beltran: I am working on doing an in-state tuition waiver for Puerto Rican students who suffered from the earthquake. Would that go through you since that is local, state, or federal government where they would get funding or would that go through SBA?
      1. Pro-Temp Davis: Tuition is dealt with by the administration of the university.
    - iii. Senator Rodriguez: Why is it coming now and why not earlier?
      1. Chair Galloway: I can't give you that answer because since I have been a senator it has been this way. Realizing that GAP didn't have the powers the other committees had is why we decided to add that.
      2. Pro-Temp Davis: The concept of GAP was a controversial topic at its original time.
