  - We are looking forward to the 8 individuals going through confirmation tonight and like last week are excited for them to be able to show their passion for servant leadership and UCF as a whole.
  - As far as my updates for this week, we began working on preparations to host the Florida Student Association which Chief of Staff Lopez will have further updates with.
  - I also attended the Faculty Senate Ad Hoc Health and Safety Committee and we discussed possibilities of a campus wide survey for faculty, professors and students regarding vaccine questions (such as hesitancy, availability, and other potentials). We will be looking in the coming weeks for answers regarding feasibility and other important questions that will need to be addressed before sending a survey out.
