- a. Senator Mitchinson - RSO limitations are being discussed in committee this week.
If you would like to check this out, come to ORS!
12. Miscellaneous Business-
- a. Brodie - Budget Quarters Breakdown (\$330,000 for the year) - The total budget is broken down per quarter. You can choose to keep it the same as last year or revise it.
 - i. Senator Spaulding - If we don't utilize the entire amount budgeted in one quarter, do those funds roll over to the quarter to be used?
 - 1. Chair Dench & Brodie - Yes
 - ii. Chair Dench - It might be a good idea to give Q1 more funding or more evenly split the budget per quarter. If the funds aren't completely spent, they would roll over to the next quarter.
 - 1. Senator Spaulding - It comes out over a little over \$80,000 quarterly and would seem wise to split it more evenly each quarter.
 - 2. Chair Dench - \$82,500 per quarter
 - 3. ORS Rep Mitchinson - We tend to receive less allocations in Q4 so it may limit the other quarters if we budget the same amount each one.
 - 4. Senator Spaulding - [directed to ORS Rep Mitchinson] How would you allocate the funds quarterly?
 - 5. ORS Rep Mitchinson - Prefers last year's quarterly budgets
 - 6. Chair Dench - Something to note: Q1 is July, August, September (beginning of the term & RSOs are looking to get funding), Q2 is October, November, December, Q3 is January, February, March, & Q4 is April, May, June. Since funding requests tend to be greater in the first quarters, it may be more beneficial to provide a more equal amount in the first three quarters and divide some up from Q4 to allocate to each.
 - 7. Brodie - You don't want to have spent all your money so there's not enough to fund in Q4, but you also don't want to reserve a bunch that doesn't get spent - look for that balance. It's not the events being held each quarter, it's what and when you're approving. Allocation requests tend to be greatest in quarter 1 & 2. I would suggest shifting more funds forward in the calendar year.

8. Chair Dench - If we equalized quarters 1,2,&3 at around \$82,000 and kept Q4 at \$30,000, there would be \$52,000 left over that could be split among the first three quarters. It would end up being \$100,000 for the first three quarters and \$30,000 for quarter 4. Any remaining funds at the end of each quarter would trickle into quarter 4 in the end.
