 - Good evening Senate, I hope you have had a great week!
 - We were so excited to welcome the Student Body Presidents from the 12 universities across the state of Florida this past weekend for FSA. Special Shoutout to Chief of Staff Lopez and Deputy Chief of Staff Martinez for organizing and covering all of the logistics for the food, venue, and content. There was a lot of good dialogue and overall we learned some great things that they are doing which we will want to bring to UCF, more on that later.
 - Last Friday Deputy Chief Martinez and I attended the UCF Alumni Board meeting where we had the chance to hear updates regarding Alumni Engagement and Annual Giving. With the \$40 Million Dollar Donation from Mackenzie Scott, they have exceeded their fundraising goal for the year hovering around over 70 million dollars.
 - We also had a chance to receive the Presidential Report from Dr. Cartwright where he expressed that the posting of the previously mentioned donation received over 7.2 Million impressions on social media in less than 48 hours.
 - They have asked me to serve on their advocacy committee and I will make sure to update you regarding any developments in that area.
 - This Monday, President Hall, others, and myself attended the June Game Day meeting where a discussion and plan arose regarding the moving of Lake Claire Tailgates due to safety concerns. After consultation with UCFPD and SG we evaluated that there were no extreme safety concerns and that the safer option would be to advocate and protect Lake Claire Tailgates. Thus, President Hall advocated on behalf of the students and future tailgates will continue to be allowed to be held at Lake Claire
 - Today, Deputy Chief of Staff Martinez, Athletic Coordinator Bracht, and myself participated in the first round of interviews to choose the next RWC Intramural Sports Coordinator.
Lastly, I am super excited to announce tomorrow I will be chairing our first Agency and Department Strategic Planning Board. I look forward to meeting with the various Directors and leaders of the various organizations that SG supports and the collaboration that will occur.

Monica is a Navy veteran and the founder of the Transgender American Veterans Association, which advocates for and supports trans veterans throughout the country. Monica's design for the trans flag features two stripes of blue for masculine identities and men, two stripes of

pink for feminine identities and women, and a white stripe in the center for those who are intersex, gender non-conforming, or transitioning.
