[Funding for Central Florida Hillel to host High Holidays in Hillel at NorthView on September 6, 2021]

WHEREAS, Central Florida Hillel (UCF Hillel (CFH)) has been a Registered Student Organization (RSO) since 2003;
WHEREAS, The mission of UCF Hillel (CFH) is Hillel's mission is to enrich the lives of Jewish undergraduate and graduate students so that they may enrich the Jewish people and the world;
WHEREAS, Central Florida Hillel members pay dues of \$0.00 annually;
WHEREAS, Central Florida Hillel currently has 1400 active members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of High Holidays is to Host High Holiday programming, including meals and religious services, for Jewish students on campus. Jewish High Holidays include Rosh Hashanah (September 6-8), Yom Kippur (September 15-16), and Sukkot (September 20-27);
WHEREAS, These holidays are some of the most important Jewish holidays during the entire year. Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year, Yom Kippur is the day of atonement, where Jews fast for 25 hours and Sukkot commemorates the Jews wandering around the desert for 40 years. Since most Jewish students are away from their families during this season, we can provide a great experience for them to partake in Jewish traditions together. We understand how Christmas and Easter, among other holidays, are the dominant holidays across America; we want students at UCF to acknowledge the importance of these Jewish holidays to the Jewish people just as Christmas and Easter are to Christians;
WHEREAS, High Holidays has an expected attendance of 400 students; and
WHEREAS, Central Florida Hillel has received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Fifty-Third Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$4,865.62 be allocated to Central Florida Hillel from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:

| Total Central Florida Hillel Contribution | | \$4,865.63 |
| Total Senate Contribution | | \$4,865.62 |

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all unspent funds revert to their originating account by October 18, 2021;
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Central Florida Hillel may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations Review and Sanctions (ORS) Committee; and
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Central Florida Hillel completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form and returns it to ORS by October 25, 2021 as a condition of receiving funding.
