[Updates to Senate Rule 2: Committee and Caucus Member Resignations]

WHEREAS, Senate Rules require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;
WHEREAS, This resolution updates Senate Rule 2 to reflect the current procedures used for Senate business;
WHEREAS, Amends the title of Senate Rule 2 to be grammatically correct;
WHEREAS, Changes names of caucuses to not include Student Government as we don't include Student Government in our committee names; and
WHEREAS, This resolution will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Fifty-Third Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Senate Rule 2 be amended as follows:

SENATE RULE 2: STANDING COMMITTEES, AD HOC COMMITTEES, AND CAUCUSES

2.03 Caucuses

- A. At the first meeting of the Student Body Senate following the completion of Senate Elections, the Student Body Senate shall recognize the following Caucuses
 - a. ~~Student Government~~ Asian/Pacific Islander American Caucus
 - b. ~~Student Government~~ Black Caucus
 - c. ~~Student Government~~ Hispanic/Latinx Caucus
 - d. ~~Student Government~~ LGBTQ+ Caucus
 - e. ~~Student Government~~ Womxn's Caucus

2.06 Membership of Committees


- A. Any committee member may resign at any time by submitting a written resignation to the Committee Chair **or the Senate President**.
- B. The Senate President may remove a committee member from any committee with written concurrence of the Senate Executive Committee which may be overturned by a majority vote of the Student Body Senate.
- C. **The Senate President may remove a committee member from any committee upon verbal concurrence of the committee member at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Student Body Senate during miscellaneous business.**

2.07 Membership of Caucuses

- A. Any Student Government Agent who identifies with the mission of a Caucus.
 1. No Student Government Agent shall be barred from membership.
- B. Any Caucus member may resign by submitting a written resignation to the Caucus Chair **or the Senate President**.

- C. **The Senate President may remove a caucus member from any caucus upon verbal concurrence of the caucus member at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Student Body Senate during miscellaneous business.**
