Resolution 53-08**

[Updates to Senate Rule 5: Amending Proclamation's Applicable Uses]

**WHEREAS**, Article 2.05(C) of the Student Body Constitution states that the Student Body Senate shall “express the will and sentiments of the Student Body Senate through legislation;”  
**WHEREAS**, Senate Rules currently allow for Proclamations to be written and passed to celebrate extraordinary events, organizations, or individuals on behalf of all Student Government Agents;  
**WHEREAS**, This Resolution amends Proclamations, to allow for the Student Government to express its sentiments over an event, organization, or individual in any manner, whether it be positive or negative; and  
**WHEREAS**, Proclamations would remain a measure to also recognize or celebrate extraordinary or notable events, organizations, or individuals;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Fifty-Third Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Senate Rule 5 be amended as follows:

**5.01 Definitions of Measures**

- A. Fiscal Bills are defined as
  - 1. Measures allocating Activity and Service Fee funds.
- B. Internal Bills are defined as
  - 1. Measures amending the Student Body Statutes.
  - 2. Measures proposing a law not contradictory to The University of Central Florida Student Body Constitution.
- C. Resolutions are defined as
  - 1. Measures pertaining to Senate Rule.
  - 2. Measures expressing the sentiment of the Student Body Senate.
- D. Proclamations are defined as
  - 1. Measures recognizing, ~~or celebrating~~, **or denouncing** extraordinary events, organizations, or individuals on behalf of all Student Government Agents. These measures require the signatures of the Senate President and Student Body President.
  - 2. These measures should be utilized sparingly as to preserve their significance and exclusivity.
- E. Special Acts are defined as
  - 1. Measures operating only upon a particular person or private concern.
  - 2. Measures pertaining to creating new statutes that do not amend nor delete current statutes and their meanings.
- F. Constitutional Amendments are defined as
  - 1. Measures amending The University of Central Florida Student Body Constitution.
