  - This week, I met with members of the LJR and E&A Committee to recommend some statutory changes. I am happy to hear that over the next couple of weeks, a number of changes will be implemented that will provide some clarity on the purpose of legislation and provide the Student Body with a more fair and representative election process.
  - The Chief Justice and I have received a high number of advising requests with the start of the semester. We will slowly but surely work through these to make sure that each student receives advising.
  - Today, you expected a number of organizations to express their support or disagreement with apportioning funding for an organization to host a speaker. Hearing from our Student Body is always a priority! Regardless, there are important reminders in deciding whether to approve or deny this request:
    - The Code of Ethics (Title XI) notes in Chapter 1100.14 that “No Student Government Agent shall allow personal interest to influence a vote.” In UCF Policy 2-600, the University does encourage its employees to support issues of their choice. **Nonetheless, the decision to provide funding (or the decision to not provide funding) cannot be based on an organizations’/individuals’ political affiliation or belief.** As such, I trust that this Senate will proceed with discretion in reaching this decision.
