 - i. WeChat and QQ ban Issue
 - 1. In April, the University banned TikTok, WeChat and QQ from being use while on UCF wifi. CSSA and ASA released a statement, expressing their concern for students who have family in China, and are not able to stay in contact with them through WeChat and QQ, which are communication apps. This can be hard on a students mental health, as they have lost the ability to connect with their loved ones, and both RSO's are hoping to find a solution that will help students be able to contact their families.
 - 2. How do you think that we can help these RSO's and make their concerns heard in a productive manner?
 - a. Akhila Reach out to DNI coordinator as they have good communication, or the VP of DEI so we can start conversations / need to figue out a way to addresss this with RSO that have concerns
 - b. Hameed Had a meeting with Senator Mittal, working on sending out a form to a few different RSO's to get a better

- understanding of how this issue is impacting students on campus, will be sent out with the RSO allocations email.
- c. Fintel Has been invited to CECS Dean's Advisory Board dinner event to talk about issue, claims that other external sources to help pressure the college about the issue.
- d. Carter Can this be brought up in Dean meetings?
 - i. Yes, but first reach out to UCF ITs / hopefully we won't have to if we can find a solution beforehand
- e. Temple May want to also speak with MSC
- f. Hurst Senator Hameed, maybe some of these resources will be helpful to you as we move forward.
- ii. What are some projects that you would like to see SBA focus on for this semester/session?
 - Carter Food Waste Managment; reusuable containers as opposed to non-reusable products, and reducing food waste and shame for using the food pantry.
 - Traynor Last session SBA did not have much involvement in this, mostly brought up to aberetum. Have investingated Dinning services for food quality validation
 - Yalamanchili From previous session, the idea that the leftover swipes for meal plans be given for needed students.
 - Temple Can attest to that, so absolutely reach out to dinning services for that as bring up education issues for that.
 - ii. Richmond Make an initiative to give away dinning dollars.
 - c. Kennaugh Possible liability issues (seconded by Hameed)
 - i. Temple Talk to ARAMARK
 - ii. Traynor Have to throw out excessive food (legality reasons) so card swipes deals would be very impactful (not sure how that would work with ARAMARK)
 - d. Yalamanchili Claims that ARAMARK must cater to selective food (not the best ethnic food), so reach out to UCF to fix that / possibly have other vendors with more traditional foods.
 - e. Carter Downtown campus has few food options, and doesn't accept dining dollars
 - Acosta Homelessness and related issues in need of assistance throughout the university. They have trouble accessing resources from the university. Could bring more awareness to the issue and get them some help accessing those resources

 Fintel - RSO's have meetings and sometimes good speakers but no place to meet, and the process of securing a room is difficult, so wants to work on a more accessible way to find big rooms in the engineering building to host meetings and/or speakers

 - 1. What questions can we ask on the concern form that students will actually answer? Having issues with required paragraph answers.

 - b. Traynor personal info (major and college) to help characterize the person, different ways to communicate concerns, when you open it different ways for financial, no multiple-choice questions before just a few paragraph options (what's your problem, what could SBA do, SG do, and the university do?)
 - c. Carter option that asks how much do you know about SG with different levels and a question that asks what they want SG to do
 - d. Hurst wants to tweak question to make it less vague so we can garner more info through more direct questions to gain a better understanding of what the student body needs
