- Fintel: Hello everyone, I hope you're all having a good week. I would like to address the issue brought up at the start of this Senate Meeting and the words of the RSO leadership that came in. As a senator from the college of engineering and computer sciences, of which many of these groups are from, I believe I am well suited to attest to the good that these RSOs have been able to put out into the college and the world at large through their efforts. I have seen firsthand the outcome of their hard work in the quality of their members and the connections they have made both within UCF and outside the university with many large companies. These RSOs are a huge draw for companies to get involved with UCF and, as one speaker said, for potential students to come to UCF. Part of what allows these groups to be able to keep all these amazing things going is the monetary backing to do so. I will not assume to know the intricacies of the budget and all the ways the funding is divided and used, but I do know many of these RSOs and I know they would not have come here today if they were not truly hurting because of this decision. For this reason, I would urge every senator to consider heavily what they said today and be open to solutions these RSOs may present in the future. Thank you.

- Hi, I just want to preface by saying I will fight not only for students but also for our branch and the checks and balances of Student Government. When it comes to my debate in negation today, I want to clarify that last session, a candidate had things on a public-facing social media account where they were perceived to have racial biases and discrimination against a specific group of people, and a lot of Senators took that as an important factor on how that candidate could work supporting all students, and the candidate received many "No" votes. I also want to clarify that E&A is a committee that strictly looks at qualifications from materials and that Senate is not E&A and does not have to be held to that strict standard, because at that point, why see the candidate on the floor at all? Therefore, I will not be accepting Speaker Holmes' opinion not to see questions or debate regarding anything outside of the submitted materials. Honestly, I don't care that much if someone has ucf.sg in their bio, but I do really care when our speech is limited by Speaker Holmes when she preaches allowing free speech in these meetings.
- In these cases today, they were no where near that past situation, however, the concern that the Executive Branch as a whole does not respect us nor our power of checks and balances remains as similar (but frankly much more concerning) things occurred last session as well. Please keep in mind that confirmations have and always will be

Senates power and that we should take our time and be thorough with them. Please also consider the fact that we have an important duty to students and not the Executive Branch. I want to ask you all to think about a situation where a candidate posts things speaking negatively about groups of students or simply saying "(insert curse word) Student Government," should we not consider it then?

- I know that when I say things people in power don't want to hear I get a target on my back, but I will not stop asking the questions nobody else will ask. If you ever feel uncomfortable bringing up a concern or problem, I will gladly and proudly do it for you, and not care what people think of me for doing so. I have already done that several times this session and last, and want to extend that to all of you.
- With that, I urge Speaker Holmes to rethink her decision and for you all to consider the implications of our speech being limited and the effects limited speech can have on supporting, protecting, and advocating for students. Thanks!
