 - OTD: In 1848, the Seneca Falls Convention, which would be a seminal event in the fight for women's suffrage and broader women's rights concluded. From this convention a Declaration of Sentiments was published, whereby women and male activists had signed their names onto the document that advocated that women were equal to men, utilizing a very similar rhetorical structure and language to that of the Declaration of Independence.
 - ∠ Quick Football Update: The Women's World Cup started today in Oceania! Australia and New Zealand both won against Ireland and Norway, resepctively 1-0. NZ's win is not only an upset (they are 26th in the world vs Norway's 12th), this match was their first win in the history of the competition outright! Nigeria and Canada play tonight at 10:30 PM EST!


