[Funding for 5 members of the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter to travel to the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society Annual Meeting in Washington, DC, from October 23rd, 2023 to October 27th, 2023]

**WHEREAS**, The Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter has been a Registered Student Organization since 1998;  
**WHEREAS**, The mission of Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter is to facilitate discussion of our discipline, assist students with professional development, disseminate information, and to increase awareness of human factors and ergonomics;  
**WHEREAS**, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter members pay dues of \$10 annually;  
**WHEREAS**, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter currently has 21 active, dues-paying members;  
**WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society Annual Meeting is to allow UCF students to present their own research and to volunteer, chair sessions, network, and learn from experts in the field.  
**WHEREAS**, HFES members attending the conference will bring back information on research that will be spread across the student body. Additionally, our presence at this conference will allow us to recruit potential graduate students for UCF.  
**WHEREAS**, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter will be lodging at the Washington Hilton Hotel; and  
**WHEREAS**, Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter received \$0 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Fifth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$2,181.72 be allocated to the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter completes a Post-Funding Form and returns it to the Operations, Review, and Sanctions Committee (ORS); and  
**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That Human Factors and Ergonomics Society - Student Chapter completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by December 4th, 2023, as a condition of receiving funding.
