 - 1. Vorn: I am Lisianna, but I go by Lisi! I am an Accounting major with a women and gender studies minor! I am from Cambodia, a former SGLCer and ELCer and worked for Val Demings! A few of my priorities would be through events like the Student Health Fair to have the caucus interact with students. Further, I want to work with Exec's Graphic Designer for Merch. I wanted to reach out to our RSOs to connect with them on our events and theirs while providing information. I wanted to work with SBA and GAP regarding reproductive rights. We have a tentative date of 20 October, I wanted to work with CAPS, KHKP, STI Services, WHPS, Smoke Free UCF



and our RSOs that discuss Planned Parenthood-type work and professional RSOs for women. I wanted to create a map for free contraceptives and issue free feminine hygiene kits that women would need in the event in an emergency. A pack of 60 goes for \$200. A Sexual Assault Awareness Event is something I wanted to work on in April by showcasing resources for sexual assault victims (ie Title IX procedures and how to report sexual assaults). I'd like to have various UCF agencies (like SCS, Victim Services, UCFPD) as well as the relevant SG agents and provide info on rape kits. I want students to pledge that they report sexual assault activities for students and make a post about it. If a student is assaulted, having knowledge on reporting process with Title IX can help them. (Speech Extended by 2 minutes). Because of the seriousness of this event, I want this to be small. I want to work with GD on getting tote bags to fit our budget, both in design and quantity. I want to also expand our RSO list, train them with CRT and FAO, and I wanted to inquire with them on a monthly basis. (Time Yielded)
