- n. Proclamation Designating October 2023 as LGBTQ+ History Month
 - i. Who do we want to send it to?
 - 1. Hameed: RSOs that are affected by it to see if they would like to sponsor it,
 - 2. Carter: Lavendar Council as well as MSC. Do we want to send it to the president's office?
 - Hameed: Yes, in most things, everyone sends it to same people towards the top, can copy and paste from that, always to Cartwright, VP of diversity equity inclusion, Asst. Dir of student success and wellbeing, multicultural center, prez of diversified greek council, and then a bunch of student associations too.
