[Funding for Formula Student to build a small formula-style vehicle for Formula SAE Michigan at Michigan International Speedway on May 17th, 2024]

**WHEREAS**, Formula Student has been a Registered Student Organization since 2000;  
**WHEREAS**, The mission of Formula Student is to represent UCF in international collegiate engineering competitions while supporting the community and enhancing students' educational experience;  
**WHEREAS**, Formula Student members pay dues of \$30 semesterly;  
**WHEREAS**, Formula Student currently has 77 active, dues-paying members;  
**WHEREAS**, The purpose of the Formula SAE Michigan Event is to challenge students to design, fabricate and compete a small formula-style vehicle. The competition allows students to demonstrate the creative process and engineering skills in comparison to peers from other universities around the world. In addition, the competition allows students the opportunity to network with automotive and aerodynamic industry insiders to improve their knowledge, skills and abilities;  
**WHEREAS**, Competing in this event representing UCF, it will bring notoriety and create recruiting tools to promote UCF among future Knights. It would also improve the UCF's engineering department standings among its peers, a recognition of student's academic success through UCF's program and overall, create a positive school's reputation;  
**WHEREAS**, The expected turnout for Formula SAE Michigan Event is 70 student attendees; and  
**WHEREAS**, Formula Student received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Fifth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$25,000.00 be allocated to Formula Student from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:
