 - 55-06 [Proclamation Recognizing the Dates Between September 15th, 2023 through October 15th, 2023 as Hispanic Heritage Month] (5//5/5)
 - 1. Speech (5):
 - a. DiChara: This proclamation is to recognize Sept 15-19 for Hispanic Heritage Week. We've worked with HSI with this. This is a formality, we are recognizing the month of Hispanic Heritage Month, we've gathered data of the states and the importance of this month, and we've added it's importance at UCF.
 - 2. Questioning (5):
 - Damarla: Thank you for this piece of legislation, we want to make sure that there is action beind this, so I want to know what you've been working on your initiatives.
 - Dichara: We've played a very supportive role with HSI, and their initiatives and events. We've also looked at scholarship accessibility within the
