Speaker Holmes has established with E&A Confirmations that germane debate only includes submitted material, no matter what outside concerns we may have had. If I were Larson, I'd appeal this to the Judicial Council, as this seems discriminatory.

- - Contrary to Chair Borge's statement, I indeed did not say it is in regards to submitted materials, but rather relevancy. If you recall, a senator was asked about what their political affiliation is during confirmations. To represent the student body, regarding the colleges is not an issue germane specific to her confirmation. Julian Larson is the individual who mentioned his attendance in senate as a whole. So on this floor, debate responding to that is relevant. Aside from this: Regarding his attendance to a dean meeting during committee, I allowed the questioning and debate because I believed that attendance in the senate is relevant to the attendance of the dean meeting. Not only did I allow debate regarding

overall attendance, Chair Borges apologized for mentioning that he didn't agree with that decision during debate. I not only told him then that he was allowed to disagree and state his opinion, but after adjourning I reiterated that same thing. If I'm being quite honest, debate regarding how much he loves his boating RSO is not relevant to his attendance either. But that was allowed too. As you can see I'm a lenient chair. Chair Borges can disagree with me allowing relevancy, but discrimination was not permitted. I didn't silence any supportive or opposing views, I allowed debate based on the wishes of the committee and senate, and a vote count allowing "yes, no, and abstention" was not withheld from any members. Saying that the majority decision of this body coupled with my impartialness "seems discriminatory" is on the mere border of accusatory, and I will not stand for such a thing. Your opinion is your own, but your closing statement is okay whatsoever unless you have valid evidence.
