 - Retention
 - Graduating on time

Initiatives

- Equal Focus on Social Sciences
 - o COS prioritizes more traditional STEM majors compared to the social sciences
 - Expand SI and SARC services to more social sciences



- Dean Response: Needs some representation on what is lacking, some students aren't utilizing the resources that we are providing. Will find and send over the communication that we have to confirm this.
- Collaborating with COS Ambassadors and Alumni Advocacy Board to Address Student Concerns and Priorities
 - Senate circulates COS ambassadors concern form
 - Senate and COS ambassadors have the same goal of approaching problems through concern forms
 - Establishing a meeting with COS ambassadors semesterly to boost cross collaboration
 - Dean Response: Attempted to do this last year and did not hear back. Social media is a big part of the ambassador program. We have struggled with communication and social media, but collaborated.
 - Laurel: I wanted to establish wanting to meet semesterly with the ambassadors to talk about what we can collaborate on and build a relationship with them.
- Advising Department within the COS
 - Increasing accessibility to appointments
 - Creating a chat box for the website that can answer simple advising questions and/or give them a link to schedule an advising appointment
 - Dean Response: It is offered at the University Knights of Exploration office; they are looking to put it on the college website but not sure when. It is university led.
- More Accessible Ways to Find Internships and Research Opportunities
 - Establishing an organized way to find opportunities
 - Right now, website has little ads, because flyers create a disparity in where to find opportunities
 - Dean Response: I see how that can be helpful, this is the most common thing that students come to me about. We should think about how we can make it more organized.
- Deans Speak at Open Forum Once a Semester

 - Dean Response: That's good to know. One thing I've said before, they are good
- Collaborate to Advertise the COS Instagram

 - Establish a social media manager internship
