- b. Legislative Watch:
 - i. Today the governor signed Florida's budget for FY25. It amounted to \$116.5 billion. There was over a billion dollars in line-item vetoes which is a power held by the Govenor to strike certain budget allocations from the proposal
 - ii. SB 1698 that would effectively ban THC oils was vetoed by the Govenor. It is a big win for Florida's hemp industry, especially ahead of the amendment 3 vote.
 - iii. The Florida Supreme Court had two major decisions this week. One that would keep a state attorney suspended by Govenor DeSantis for neglect of duty on suspension and one that found SB 254, a bill that blocked access transgender healthcare, unconstitutional.
