 - i. There was a massive Orlando city council special election this week. Shan Rose narrowly beat out Travaris McCurdy to finish out Regina Hill's term who was suspended. This was also a run-off election as Rose and McCurdy were the top vote getters in the first round of the election. The race was nasty with potent smear campaigns run by both candidates. It is notable that McCurdy had Orlando mayor Buddy Dyer's sponsorship but was still unable to win.
 - ii. Governor DeSantis has faced staunch criticism this week from teachers' unions as they claim that is is misrepresenting the pay increase they are getting in the FY25 budget. He has touted the pay increase as a major success of the budget, but the unions claim the increase only amounts to around 50 cents per hour for each teacher which they claim is inadequate.
