- a. Possible future events?
  - i. Vasquez: SBA also goes to other events to support them and advertise student government. Last event started as an initiative and the want to make a proclamation. People wanted more promotion/ wanted donation times open longer. The rso's wanted to do it again. We went to H4H's distribution event in downtown orlando (SO Speaker Pohlmann and ELA Richmond).
