 - i. The University of Florida suspended 9 students arrested during the campus protests about the ongoing conflict in the Middle East. The suspensions range from 3-4 years. Each student presented their case in front of a hearing body composed of faculty but the Dean of Students, Chris Summerlin, overruled many of this body's sentences that were lighter on the students than the multi-year suspensions Summerlin doled out. Each student has appealed the punishment. Each student is also facing criminal prosecution and has pleaded not quilty.
