[Funding for 33 members of Society of Woman Engineers to travel to the WE24 in Chicago, Illinois from October 24<sup>th</sup> 2024 to October 26<sup>th</sup> 2024]

**WHEREAS**, Society of Woman Engineers (SWE) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1975;  
**WHEREAS**, The mission of SWE is to enhance female engineers' professional skills, promote the value of women engineers and encourage young women to consider an engineering education;  
**WHEREAS**, SWE currently has 266 active members;  
**WHEREAS**, The purpose of the WE24 is to invite attendees to live without limits while engaging in networking, gaining career insights, and connecting with industry leaders on innovation. Participants can attend interactive workshops on leadership and engineering subjects, cultivating relationships and empowering women;  
**WHEREAS**, Attendees will engage in interactive workshops, gain insights from industry leaders, and explore cutting-edge technologies. Panel discussions on emerging trends and best practices will infuse fresh perspectives into UCF's academic community. Tailored sessions for early-career professionals and aspiring leaders will foster growth and networking opportunities. Notably, many attendees secure internships and full-time offers, enhancing UCF's reputation and students' career prospects;  
**WHEREAS**, SWE will be lodging at the Hyatt Place Chicago/River North in Chicago, Illinois; and  
**WHEREAS**, SWE received \$0 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$12,096.28 be allocated to Society of Woman Engineers from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

**BE IT FURTHER ENACTED**, That the Society of Engineers completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024 as a condition of receiving funding.
