[Funding for American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics to begin a project on rocket design with an expected participation of 70 students]

WHEREAS, American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1990;
WHEREAS, The mission of AIAA is to further within its locality the purpose and programs of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics;
WHEREAS, AIAA members pay dues of \$30 annually;
WHEREAS, AIAA currently has 246 active, dues-paying members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to have students learn sound engineering practices by designing, building, and launching a mid-power rocket;
WHEREAS, students will learn how to use SolidWorks, simulation software, and they will learn to work within real world constraints and aerodynamic fundamentals of mid-powered rockets;
WHEREAS, The expected turnout for this project is 70; and
WHEREAS, American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics received \$0.00 via FAO/CRT Allocation in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$925.12 be allocated to American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:
