University of Central Florida Fifty-Sixth Student Body Senate Proclamation 56-12

[Proclamation recognizing September 15th, 2024 through October 15th, 2024 as Hispanic Heritage Month]

WHEREAS, Senate Rule 2.04(G)(1) states that the Student Body Advocacy (SBA) Committee shall pass measures advocating on behalf of the student body regarding student and university affairs at the University of Central Florida (UCF);

WHEREAS, Senate Rule 5.01(D)(1) states that Proclamations are defined as measures recognizing, celebrating, or condemning extraordinary events, organizations, or individuals on behalf of all Student Government Agents;

WHEREAS, Hispanic Heritage Month began as a week-long celebration in 1968 under president Lyndon B. Johnson;

WHEREAS, President Reagan expanded it to a month in 1988 to have more time to celebrate Hispanic/Latino achievements;

WHEREAS, The dates chosen are significant as Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua celebrate their independence day on September 15th;

WHEREAS, Followed by Mexico on the 16th, Chile on the 18th, and Belize on the 21st;

WHEREAS, As of 2024, there are 65.62 million Hispanic/Latino individuals in the United States, making up 19.5% of the population;

WHEREAS, This makes Hispanics/Latinos the largest ethnic or racial group in the United States;

WHEREAS, In Florida, Hispanic/Latino individuals are the second largest ethnic/racial group at 26%;

WHEREAS, History has seen millions of Hispanic/Latino individuals move to the United States, more specifically Florida, for a better life;

WHEREAS, Immigrants and descendants of immigrants have added to the culture, economy, and overall wellbeing of the state of Florida;

WHEREAS, The University of Central Florida prides itself on its Hispanic/Latino student population, with 29.2% of students being Hispanic/Latino in 2023;

WHEREAS, UCF received the Seal of Excelencia in 2021, and through the office of Hispanic Serving Institutions Initiative provides Hispanic/Latino focused career development programs such as Latinx Leadership, CREAR Futuros, and Nuestra Celebracion; and WHEREAS, UCF is committed to highlighting the diversity and excellence of their students, through acknowledging the contributions made by the Hispanic/Latino community on campus and beyond.
