[Funding for 12 members of International Medical Outreach to travel to the India Service Trip in Aurangabad, India from December 6th 2024 to December 17th 2024]

WHEREAS, International Medical Outreach (IMO) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2006;
WHEREAS, The mission of IMO is to underserved communities across the globe. Through efforts in education and volunteering, our mission hopes not only to improve upon the sustainability and efficacy of medical care in the areas we serve, but to instill in our members an ethos of multiculturalism and medical altruism that shall continue throughout their lives. By means of our members and mission, we hope to leave a lasting legacy of medical care, service, and compassion within all of the areas we serve;
WHEREAS, IMO members pay dues of \$40 annually;
WHEREAS, IMO currently has 454 active dues-paying members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of the India Service Trip is to Collaborate with Sewa International, Sevankur Bharat, and Dr. Hedgewar Rughalaya Hospital to perform volunteer work and medical shadowing;
WHEREAS, Members will get hands-on experience in healthcare provisioning in a foreign context, as well as exposure to Maharashtrian culture through interactions with physicians, students, and significant sites; and
WHEREAS, International Medical Outreach received \$0 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2024- 2025 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$12,020.69 be allocated to International Medical Outreach from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That International Medical Outreach completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by January 28th, 2025, as a condition of receiving funding.
