[Funding for American Society of Mechanical Engineers to create the ASME Internal Projects at UCF Engineering Atrium, on April 30th, 2025]


WHEREAS, American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) has been a Registered Student Organization 1970;
WHEREAS, The mission of ASME is to promote the field of Mechanical Engineering on the UCF campus;
WHEREAS, ASME members pay dues of \$35 annually;
WHEREAS, ASME currently has 96 active dues-paying members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of the ASME Internal Projects is to teach UCF students the relevant skills needed in the Mechanical Engineering Industries. The projects will include land vehicle design/assembly, aquatic vehicle design/assembly, structural design, coding, and more;
WHEREAS, The projects funded using this bill will teach students coding, mechatronics, and how to use tools both physical and digital. These projects will be presented at project showcases hosted by UCF; and
WHEREAS, American Society of Mechanical Engineers received \$799.00 from FAO 56-37, \$2,000.00 from FAO 56-42, and \$700 from Fiscal Bill 56-17 for a total of \$3,499.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$1,000.00 be allocated to American Society of Mechanical Engineers from the Senate Working Fund according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all unspent funds revert to their originating account by May 30th, 2025;
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That American Society of Mechanical Engineers may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations Review and Sanctions Committee (ORS); and
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That American Society of Mechanical Engineers completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by June 6, 2025, as a condition of receiving funding.
