Internal Bill 56-09**

[Updates to Title VIII: Changes to the Expected RSO Contribution on Fiscal Bills]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant revision to best serve the student body;
WHEREAS, The intent behind a fiscal bill is to equally split costs between the Senate and an RSO;
WHEREAS, Under the current statutes, RSOs that reach the funding cap may have their contribution set higher than the Senate's on fiscal bill;
WHEREAS, This can lead to a situation where an RSO may be expected to contribute vastly higher than the Senate contributes, even though they have no sanctions;
WHEREAS, This bill proposes changing statutes to make it so that both the Senate and RSO contribution on a fiscal bill are always set to 50%, unless the RSO has active sanctions; and
WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title VIII be amended as follows:

Chapter 812 Funding Classifications

- 812.1 Senate Bills: The funding amount for Senate Bills shall be ~~up to~~ 50% of total eligible costs, unless:
- A. There are sanctions imposed by the Operations Review and Sanctions (ORS) Committee.
 - B. ~~The RSO has reached their total funding limit.~~
 - C. The RSO requests a lower funding level.

Chapter 822 Funding Classifications

- 822.1 Senate Bills: The funding level for Senate Bills shall be 50% of total eligible cost for projects and events, unless:
- A. There are sanctions imposed by the Operations Review and Sanctions (ORS) Committee.
 - B. ~~The RSO has reached their total funding limit.~~
 - C. The RSO requests a lower funding level.
