 - f. Morosov: Cost of \$1680 for PD, could you not have shorter period of physical donation collection?
 - Several RSOs doing fundraisers the whole time at their stands, not a short period
 - ii. Morosov: Can fundraising be done online rather than through cash?
 - Have that, one of the largest participants brings about 40 middle schoolers who don't have phones or cards. Have PD through Relay for Life rules
 - g. Rose: Collect \$1100, would you not be better off just not paying for police officers?
