  - (a) Section 504 prohibits discrimination of disability rights. Section 504 should be protected and advocated for as it protects disabled people in healthcare, education, and various other categories. Without 504, disabled people will lose access to their rights. Currently, Texas vs. Becerra is attempting to get rid of 504 along with 17 other states which includes Florida. If section 504 is lost, many people will be negatively impacted financially, medically, jobs/employment, and much more. As Florida is one of the states on the list, it should be advocated and protected to be kept instead of removing 504.
