 - i) Resolution 56-35 [Resolution Advocating for Housing Affordability and Environment and Sustainability Efforts at the State Level] [Chair Vasquez] (ADOPTED IN COMMITTEE 6-0-2)
 - (1) Speech:
 - (a) Vasquez: The two topics covered by this resolution are housing affordability and sustainability. We discussed that we cant take every bill but we can still bring it on our agendas and speak it on it. We specifically chose these because it was the most written in and was the second highest under public welfare. These two bills are still very alive and seeing action on the floor, we would be strongly in favor of as it would help students facing or at risk of homelessness in the state of Florida. Requires offices to conduct research surrounding homelessness and make universities give priority to students applying for on campus housing as homeless or provide proper support systems for those students. Other bills are for the environment, revolve around recycling plans and carbon sequestering.
