- 1. Meredith Varner Associate Director, Housing occupancy management. Manage team that does housing app, roommate matching process.
- Jennifer Fazal: Assistant director of assignments team, previous coordinator in residence life. Supervising the assignments staff, overseeing ESA accommodations, etc.

ii. Discussion:

- 1. Varner: Seeing a different purpose of questions, discuss further, providing ways to get people to get to know each other and explore, we cannot provide 100% accurate information, not looking to provide someone with an exact match based on the questions, encourage communication. Source of questions, working with teams in communities, top items students have roommate conflicts about. Temperature and Trash. We could take some additional inspiration from this list. Could be beneficial for students. Introverted and extroverted tendencies. Part of the reason our questions have limited responses, the more responses, lower match percentage, keep answers as limited as possible, to provide higher matches. System allows students to pick priority matches, encourages discussion between students. Have things implemented before November, before applications open for incoming freshmen.
 - a. Hameed: Concept of survey would be helpful for incoming freshmen.
 - b. Lazo: Asking former freshmen, former system in past years.
 - c. Hameed: Implement it in move-out process, to get feedback.
- Al-Qudah: When questions were originally brainstormed, would a review of the questions be valuable again. Different demographics provide unique insight. Improving lifestyle questions.
