# Internal Bill 56-08

- Varela: think we should change it to not give ors the power of fiscal appeals. Spent the last week looking into the history of them, and i found a supreme court case (real life) from 2000 called board of regents of university of Wisconsin vs southworth, said any process that distributes student activity fees money has to have a neutral appeal boyd, concerned that ors' neutrality can be a problem in appeals. Still think we should run with amendments last time, It wouldn't really take away ors' power, was talking with Daniel. If there was an RSO that came and said they paid back business office "can i be unsanctioned", ors could give the expert opinion to judicial, it would be quick and most appropriate way to get something changed. - Hendry: Can Sanctions stack?
- Rose: Yes

- Rose: I would still prefer it to be in ORS's hands. But it's not a deal breaker to give
  judicial power

- Lazo: I'm not super confident since it is complex and controversial
