nursing as it relates to transportation alternatives to commuting nursing students as well as dining options at the Lake Nona Campus.

- Greene: Basically, some of the issues I wanted to bring up to Brawley included: how much nursing students have to commute, the cost of commuting, and an overhauled shuttle system to Lake Nona. The shuttle thing is kind of unfeasible because nursing students are so sparse. We were floating the idea of a stipend, but we don't know how that'd work because we don't know what students would actually be using the money on. Also brought up the idea of expanding our Lyft program to Cocoa and Daytona campuses. Last thing, we brought up expanding food options on Lake Nona. There are NO food options at Lake Nona and students would love to have a cafe. The COM has a cafeteria area, so maybe when the nursing college opens at Lake Nona, we could utilize that area.
 - a. Jolicoeur: What about a credit system? What are students spending the most money on?
 - b. Greene: There's a Tropical Smoothie Cafe. Students would like more options like the main campus does.
 - c. Jolicoeur: Maybe implement food trucks? Back to credits, we give credits for printing and stuff...why not for commuting?
 - d. Varela: I am very pleased with the progress on Lake Nona, this is a campus that I knew very little about but we're making a difference.
