I am very new to SG, so would love feedback on any of my ideas and initiatives. Plan to collab with caucuses and committees, to work on a large fundraising endeavor, working with all these different groups, divide it between each of the caucuses and use it for events, having this event involve food, exploring cultural issues. More Outreach encourages students to stay up to date on what SG does. Black mentorship program, collaborating with local, regional, state high schools and becoming mentors for high school students, semester long, credit or volunteer hours in return.

- Questioning (5):
 - Butler: When elected, what would be the first initiative to work on?
 - Beneche: Outreach, working with students firsthand, and seeing what issues they may have. Know the community.



- Metellus: Black Business Showcase, we have already started discussing some ideas, and executing them. Want to get UCF concern form created, to have it there while we table.
 Communicating with other leadership in black UCF.
- Courts: How do you plan on highlighting black UCF every day?
 - Metellus: Maintaining a strong connection and advertise them on our social media pages. Ask them how we can help with initiatives and goals
 - Beneche: To highlight and uplift, we have to connect with them. One idea that I had was to post on the UCFSG Instagram story, to highlight what black UCF is doing and endorse it by the Black Caucus. Advertising in senate, group chat with black RSO leadership
- Butler: How do you plan on collaborating with orgs and caucuses?
 - Beneche: As touched on, I want to collaborate with cultural caucuses, SBA and GAP as well, it would be advantageous, and inviting members of exec to our meetings and allowing them to participate in open forum. I want to email all of the black RSOs and let them know what the Caucus is about, schedule a time for them to meet with us
 - Metellus: In addition to collaborating with GAP to get black voters to the polls, I spoke to Morissette and Courts about collaborating with other caucuses to do a town hall so students know who is representing them. Giving a more personal interaction would be beneficial, and collaborating with other caucuses would also benefit our constituents
