      - 1. Transparency of outside funding brought to fiscal. CRT & ORS like, CRT just wanted to include individuals, not just RSOs. Many situations where people come to ORS bc they reverted 100% since some other source covered 100% of the funding. Hopefully help them to better allocate their resources and not have to go through ORS. Is SG first place people look for funding or just when they have no other options? If department funds will cover requests, that could be good.
        - a. Morissette: Clarify whether this is just department sponsored or all RSOs?
          - i. Know they're getting recategorized, could wait until after, but would like it to apply to all RSOs. Don't want it to seem like we're using this info to pick and choose who's getting funding.
        - b. Hameed: Do you know when RSOs are officially recategorized?
          - i. Morissette: Soft launched, this semester, hard launch in Fall
            - 1. Hameed: So summer?
              - a. Morissette: Finalized for everyone by fall
          - ii. Hameed: Legislation eventually changing language away from RSOs and to a more updated term. Lot of big bills happen in summer, would still want this bill passed this summer
          - iii. Morissette: 3 types of orgs, department-sponsored, affiliated, and general. DSSOs could be determined

1. Kaufman: Would you predict a bill changing the way funding is structured in Fall?
  - a. Morissette: Maybe, not a lot of RSOs being affected, mostly CECS RSOs
- c. Rubin: What if an RSO is planning to do a trip but hasn't done fundraisers and stuff at time of request?
  - i. Lazo: Common question that we ask how they get funds for their half.
  - ii. Rubin: Says only have to provide info about what you already have.
    1. Kaufman: Good point, would expect it to be everything in plans
      - a. Wangen: Change to "have received and expect to receive"?
      - b. Hameed: "Have received and anticipate receiving"?
      - c. Muratov: In the case that people find funding after, this doesn't change anything
        - i. Kaufman: If they provide this info, can help them make the decision that this is the best route
        - ii. Muratov: Issue with potentially receiving funds, but don't know if they need it.
        - iii. Wangen: Too much to try to cover all of it after we've allocated funds, it's their job to inform CRT or FAO Chair to get the allocation changed, otherwise they go to ORS.
  - d. Kaufman: To answer why this can't just be in KnightConnect, this makes the info required instead of up to future individual's discretion.
