[Funding for 14 members of Student Nurses' Association - Orlando to travel to the National Student Nurses' Association 73rd Annual Convention in Seattle, Washington from April 8th, 2025 to April 13th, 2025]

WHEREAS, Student Nurses' Association - Orlando (SNA) has been a Registered Student Organization since 1982;

WHEREAS, The mission of SNA is to motivate students to become the next leaders in the nursing profession. We understand the foundation of nursing is a heart of compassion and that the development of the nursing profession is dependent on nurses who are able to lead wisely and collaborate effectively. SNA at UCF offers student nurses the opportunity to connect with the community through their numerous volunteer activities. Students will grow in their leadership skills as they not only enjoy special guest speakers, but also put their own leadership abilities into action;

WHEREAS, SNA members pay dues of \$47 annually;

WHEREAS, SNA currently has 105 active, dues-paying members;

WHEREAS, The purpose of the National Student Nurses' Association 73rd Annual Convention is to Participate in the House of Delegates with chapters from the entire country, gain leadership, and network with various nurse leaders. We also have a student running for the NSNA National Board;
