[Funding for 14 members of Club on Security and Intelligence to travel to the CoSI at the Capitol 2025 in Washington, D.C. from March 30th, 2025 to April 2nd, 2025]

WHEREAS, Club on Security and Intelligence (CoSI) has been a Registered Student Organization since 2015;
WHEREAS, The mission of CoSI is to foster the understanding of and advancement opportunities for students seeking careers in the intelligence community and national security through guest speakers, conferences, and building a network of like-minded individuals;
WHEREAS, CoSI members pay dues of \$25 a semester;
WHEREAS, CoSI currently has 102 active, dues-paying members;
WHEREAS, The purpose of the CoSI at the Capitol 2025 is to provide students with unparalleled networking opportunities in the Intelligence Community (IC), as well as the ability to gain first hand experience in learning what the IC has to offer in its many career fields;
WHEREAS, This will further develop the members of CoSI so that they can become more well-rounded and knowledgeable students once they return to UCF. Once back, students will be able to apply their knowledge and experience gained to not only benefit themselves in the classroom and extracurriculars, but their peers both in the RSO and their classes as well. Furthermore, by bringing UCF students to Washington, D.C., UCF is not only able to continue to build but also maintain the already strong reputation in government for UCF supplying well-versed and knowledgeable students into the defense industry;
WHEREAS, CoSI will be lodging at the 2500 Penn, a Placemakr Experience in Washington, D.C.; and
WHEREAS, Club on Security and Intelligence received \$0 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$3,825.50 be allocated to Club on Security and Intelligence from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Club on Security and Intelligence may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations, Review, and Sanctions Committee (ORS); and
BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Club on Security and Intelligence completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form by May 19th, 2025, as a condition of receiving funding.
