University of Central Florida Fifty Sixth Student Body Senate Internal Bill 56-18

[Updates to Title IX: Updating E&A's Non-Compliance jurisdiction]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;

WHEREAS, The current jurisdiction of the Elections and Appointments (E&A) Committee over non-compliance matters does not clearly outline its authority in relation to the Title 3, Senate Rule 2.03, and other relevant provisions;

WHEREAS, The expansion and clarification of E&A's jurisdiction will enhance its ability to oversee and ensure compliance with the Election Statutes, improving the election process and maintaining fairness in student representation;

WHEREAS, This bill seeks to provide clear guidelines on the E&A Committee's jurisdiction to issue Notifications of Non-Compliance in matters pertaining to elections, appointments, and other relevant statutes, as outlined in Senate Rule 2.03;

WHEREAS, These updates will provide a more efficient and transparent process for managing non-compliance issues within the

jurisdiction of the Elections and Appointments Committee, and

WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, *BE IT ENACTED*, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title be amended as follows:

 The authority to issue a "Notification of Non-Compliance" is vested in the following offices: K. The LJR, ORS, FAO, CRT, and E&A Committees of the Senate, by majority vote, under the following jurisdictions: 1. 5. The Elections and Appointments (E&A) Committee shall have jurisdiction limited to the Election Statutes, the election proceedings, and all relevant chapters as outlined in Senate Rule 2.03.
