[Updates to VI: Allowing Election Commissioners to hold Caucus Leadership Positions]

Internal Bill 56-24

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;

WHEREAS, Election Commissioners serve as student government agents;

WHEREAS, Title XIV, Chapter 1401.3(A)(1) states that any student government agent who identifies with the mission of a caucus shall be eligible for membership;

WHEREAS, Title XIV, Chapter 1402.1(A)(3) states that any student government agent on the committee shall be eligible for nomination;

WHEREAS, Election commissioners currently have the ability to be a member of a caucus but are barred from caucus leadership positions;

WHEREAS, Caucuses hold no bias or significant information that would impede the impartiality of an election commissioner; and **WHEREAS**, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, **BE IT ENACTED**, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that VI be amended as follows:

Chapter 601 The Election Commission

601.1 Membership

The Election Commission's membership shall be composed of ten (10) students from the University of Central Florida.

- A. The Supervisor of Elections will have served as an Election Commissioner at UCF for a minimum of one election period. The Senate may overturn this prerequisite by a 2/3 vote.
- **B.** The Supervisor of Elections and an Assistant Supervisor of Elections shall be appointed, from within the Commission, by the Student Body President to serve a term which ends the last week of Summer A.
- **C.** Commission members may not hold any other elected or appointed Student Government positions, with the exception of caucus leadership positions.
- D. Five (5) Election Commissioners shall be appointed each year. If a vacancy occurs, the president shall appoint a replacement to serve the remainder of the term.
- E. Commission members' terms of office shall run for two (2) consecutive Executive Administrations.
 - 1. Commissioner Seats #1-5 shall be appointed no later than the last week of Summer A of every even year (e.g., 2012)
 - 2. Commissioner Seats #6-10 shall be appointed no later than the last week of Summer A of every odd year (e.g., 2011)
 - 3. This pattern shall continue perpetually.
