Fifty Sixth Student Body Senate
Internal Bill 56-30**

[Updates to Title III: Changing Orientation Requirements]

WHEREAS, Statutes require constant updates and revision to best serve the Student Body;

WHEREAS, Senate Orientation is important to familiarize new Senators with the structure and responsibilities of the Student Body Senate;

WHEREAS, Senators who have already completed a Senate Orientation should not need to be familiarized with the structure and responsibilities of the Student Body Senate;

WHEREAS, It is already common practice for the Senate President Pro Tempore to skip Senate Orientations for returning Senators;

WHEREAS, Senators who have served in a session must have completed either the Senate Orientation Retreat or a Senate Orientation with the Senate President Pro Tempore, if they are elected to another session, they are still required to attend that new session's Senate Orientation Retreat as noted in 309.7; and

WHEREAS, This Bill will go into effect immediately.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, by the Fifty-Sixth Student Senate of the University of Central Florida that Title III be amended as follows:

Chapter 309 Senatorial Responsibilities

309.9 Any Senator appointed, receiving a sign-over, who was unable to attend the Senate Orientation Retreat, is required to attend a Senate Orientation to be scheduled with the office of the Senate President Pro Tempore within ten (10) academic days of being sworn into the Senate.

- A. An extension to comply with a Senator's requirement to attend Senate Orientation may be granted by a majority vote of the Senate Executive Committee. A majority vote of the Senate can overturn the decision of the Senate Executive Committee.
- B. **Sign-overs and appointees who have previously completed a Senate Orientation within the current or previous session may be exempt from this requirement by the Senate President Pro Tempore.**
