[Proclamation Commemorating the Exemplary Life and Achievements of Harris Rosen] WHEREAS, Senate Rule 2.04(G)(1) states that the Student Body Advocacy (SBA) Committee shall pass measures advocating on behalf of the student body regarding student and university affairs at the University of Central Florida (UCF); WHEREAS, Senate Rule 5.01(D)(1) states that Proclamations are defined as measures recognizing, celebrating, or condemning extraordinary events, organizations, or individuals on behalf of all Student Government Agents; WHEREAS, Harris Rosen sadly passed away on November 25th, 2024; WHEREAS, Harris Rosen was an incredible philanthropist and investor into the UCF and greater Orlando community; WHEREAS, Rosen's philanthropy included investing millions of dollars to send underprivileged children to preschool and college; WHEREAS, Rosen was a champion of educational accessibility with him famously saying "there is as much intellectual talent in underserved communities as there is in gated communities"; WHEREAS, Harris Rosen is the founder of the Rosen Foundation; WHEREAS, The Rosen Foundation has funded community centers and aquatic centers in underprivileged communities; WHEREAS, The Rosen Foundation has provided millions of dollars to Haiti for disaster relief; WHEREAS, The Rosen Foundation's Haiti Task Force has donated over 250 water filtration systems to Haiti; WHEREAS, The Haiti Task Force has worked on building disaster resistant housing in Haiti since Hurricane Mathew in 2016; **WHEREAS.** Harris Rosen was also committed to disaster relief in Florida: **WHEREAS.** Rosen Resorts offered vastly discounted rates to families fleeing hurricanes: WHEREAS, Thousands of Floridian families have used Rosen Resorts as shelters from hurricanes; WHEREAS, Harris Rosen was a vital figure in building Orlando's crucial hospitality industry; **WHEREAS**, Harris Rosen was the director of Hotel Planning for Walt Disney World Resorts; WHEREAS. Rosen oversaw the development of Disney's Contemporary Resort. The Polynesian Village, and Wilderness Lodge: WHEREAS, In 1974, Harris Rosen bought and developed his first hotel, a Quality Inn; WHEREAS, At the end of his career, Harris Rosen built 7 hotels along International Drive; WHEREAS, Harris Rosen is also the owner of the 4-diamond rated Rosen Shingle Creek Resort; WHEREAS, Harris Rosen has invested millions into the development of the University of Central Florida; WHEREAS.
