 - x. Cimillo: Understand the idea, but Senate isn't meant to hold events. Would like to know what this money is allocated towards.

- xiii. Morissette: Would you prefer to just raise Senate Operations rather than creating the new budget line for initiatives?
 - xiv. Wangen: Speaker initiatives was created bc it lumped a bunch of smaller budget lines together, meant for committee ideas to be able to be executed. Student Union no longer has a fund to be able to support our initiatives, so the small amount of money is important that way
 - xv. Pohlmann: Trips, conferences, etc is under professional development. Speaker initiatives is more for SBA/committee initiatives to take a next step. Advocate for vague language if we do write something
 - xvi. Cimillo: Know it's small, but it's new, want to make sure it's properly budgeted and figure out what we want to do with it. Think about what the actual purpose is.
 - xvii. Hameed: Purpose for general Senate initiatives. If we put language in, it should be vague, could write that the speaker has to sign off on anything.
 - xviii. Caringal: Current draft is that it may only be used for legislative branch purposes.
 - xix. Brawley: Don't object, but could write more detail
 - xx. Wangen: Worry that this is either super restrictive or not at all restrictive, depending how you read it
 - xxi. Caringal: Thoughts on how to write this?
 - 1. Wangen: Think it's unnecessary
 - xxii. Cimillo: Like the idea of merchandise, tabling, and outreach restriction like wording
 - xxiii. Morissette: funds would likely be used for more than just the tabling and outreach type things
 - xxiv. Brawley: Don't want it only restricted to tabling and outreach
 - xxv. Hameed: General legislative purposes, needs to allow for individual initiatives that could benefit from small amounts of money.
