The Judicial Council is made up of 14 seats, #1-7 opening every odd year (this year), #8-14 opening every even year (next year). Besides leadership, we are made up of 5 different committees, which are our working bodies; Internal Rules Committee (IRC), Precedent Committee, Judicial Outreach Committee (JOC), Judicial Advertisement and Marketing Committee (JAM), and lastly Judicial Experience Committee (JEC).
