 - (1) Sherman: Sophmore in legal studies and political science, Last year I sat on FAO and on A&SF. I've been a senator in the 56th and this session. I pride myself on my title 8 knowledge and fiscal policies. Outreach initiatives, I want to collab with SBA and other fiscal committees so students know their resources through tabling. I want to update the SG website. I want to host workshops for RSOs to learn about funding and to educate SG agents on funding procedures. If I was elected, I would want to acclimate new and old

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senators. I'd go over title 8 and going over how to represent an RSO in senate. I would ensure the master tracker is current and accurate. Attendance tracker delegated to VC. As a committee every semester we'd go over title 8 to update it. I want to uphold transparency, accountability, and professionalism. Immediate priorities. Establish our own tracker for bills and allocations. ASAP meet with the comptroller to adjust the form. For the summer I'd set the meeting and see if we can do virtual or hybrid. And I'd ensure all materials are presented to the committee.

I want to ensure there are no auditing issues for bills. I want everyone in this process to understand whats going on. I want to work with the comptroller. Equity, everyone should have a fair shot at funding. RSOs come very soon to get funding and in spring we run out. I want to hold back funds so more people can get funds. I want to hold a meeting with fiscal leadership to analyze funding to see if we need to change our stratagies. I want to hold back on expensive travel choices. Efficiency, I know this is a confusing experience for senators and students. New onboarding for new senators and mentorship program to have an advisor to help you out. Allocations and Bills, I want to see them in a first come first served basis rather than agenda order to prioritize students who need to leave sooner and the help students who might come later. Standardize scoring. Consistent guidelines for everyone. Last session I was active in committee to change our policy and I want to contine this as chair. I truly appreciate you consideration.
