 - i. Sherman: Chapter 810 is basic, mainly just definitions and eligible cost. Last week we voted on the budget per guarter. There was a little confusion about this, but we can vote to change the budget if we need to but the goal is to stick with what we have. There was a change to the CRT bill from the last session that says we can limit the number of students going to a certain conference. Last week, we said that only 20 undergrads could go to the same networking conference with this new build. There are two types of requests, bills and allocations. Bills fund 50% of eligible cost. They would send in a request and then it would be seen in the Senate. Different types of allocations are research presentation, observational research, performance arts, competition trips, Seminar/Networking trips. service trips (no religious trips). Meeting operations: must be an authorized officer, can be presented in person or on zoom. CRT committee members may represent the club if requested. Allocation requests must be submitted at least 2 days prior to the start of CRT. The Senate must approve 15 days before the event. Non-U.S citizens have 30-35 business days before their trip for their allocation to be approved. Bills must be approved 45 days before funding is

needed. 816 is general limitations. Says what CRT cannot fund. Mission or cultural trips, individual service trips, Airbnb's, social events without oversight, and study abroad/ internships.

- ii. Kapinos: What does unrestricted service events mean?
- iii. Sherman: It is up to the committee to determine but make sure that they don't have any party or religious affiliation. More things CRT can't fund. Travel more than 30 days without the provost's approval, duplicate requests for same trip, items already purchased, charted buses going farther than 500 miles. The funding for RSOs stayed the same. For Individuals it changed. Research/Performance: \$400 (down from \$500), Observation: \$400 (up from \$300), Competition: \$350 (up from \$300), Seminar: \$200 (down from \$300). There are allocation supplements. Students going to Canada, Mexico, Hawaii, and Alaska get an extra \$250. Grad students get an extra \$100 (down from \$200). Trips not in North America can get an extra \$500.
