[Funding for 2 members of Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach to travel to the 28th International Colloquium on the Dynamics of Explosions and Reactive Systems in Naples, Italy from June 18, 2022 to June 26, 2022]

WHEREAS, Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach (AERO) has been a Registered Student Organization (RSO) since 2018;

WHEREAS, The mission of Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach is to promote collaboration between students and scientists in the field of Aerospace engineering by facilitating involvement in research, industry, outreach, and mentorship for the advancement of next-generation propulsion and power technology;

WHEREAS, AERO members pay dues of \$0;

WHEREAS, Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach currently has 13 active members;

WHEREAS, The purpose of the 28th International Colloquium on the Dynamics of Explosions and Reactive Systems is to disseminate and receive fundamental concepts applicable to research being done at UCF;

WHEREAS, AERO members will have the opportunity to present research;

WHEREAS, AERO will be lodging at the Piazzale Vincenzo Tecchio & Casino in Naples, Italy; and

WHEREAS, Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach received \$0.00 in Activity and Service Fee Funds in the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Fifty-Fourth Student Body Senate of the University of Central Florida that \$3,050.00 be allocated to the Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach from the Registration and Travel Account according to the following breakdown:

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach may complete a Post-Funding Form and return it to the Operations Review and Sanctions (ORS) Committee; and

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Aerospace Engineers for Research and Outreach completes a Verification of RSO Purchases Form and returns it to ORS by July 7, 2022 as a condition of receiving funding.
