1. Speech

a. Hello, I am trying to get funding, and we have received it before. Due to political unrest this trip was postponed. In order to keep our deposit, we had to exchange money for credit on the airline. Lodging was on the original, which has changed. We would like lodging and flight price, and keep some of the flight credits

a. Wangen: Flight concerned, are the credits through the business office or yourself

i. We received flight credits but we have paid nothing to the airline, but we have not spent any money from the business.

b. Temple: How will you ensure the safety of you delegation

i. We are going to Lima, the least unrest location. If it's as bad as it is today, we will cancel the trip. We are working far away from places that has issues and unrest, the best thing we would do

c. **Temple:** POI: On 7 December 2022, President Pedro Castillo attempted to usurp Congress and consolidate state authority. This resulted in his impeachment from office and subsequent arrest. Mass protests have been ongoing since he was remanded to prison on charges of conspiracy and rebellion, throwing the country into political turmoil which has seen at least 40 protestors killed (Reuters).
